2. Feedback from EMP public presentations and review of ongoing public comment process:

- Coordinate both reporting and revised STRAW Proposal base lines that were in Energy Master Plan and better align with STRAW Proposal.
- Determine if estimates in Energy Master Plan aligns with STRAW Proposal.
- In order to achieve Straw Proposal reduction goals
 - Need to focus on transforming the market.
 - Infrastructure of C/I construction industry needs to change.
 - Trade allies need to understand Advanced Energy Building Code and how to meet it.
 - Need to focus on workforce development.
- Public hearings posted on the website.
- Draft available on the web site.
- The two public meetings that were previously held were to introduce the plan.

3. Feedback on CRA

- Hearings were held in April.
- Deadline closed May 6.
- Staff is working on recommendations for decision at June 11 Board Meeting.
- Usage request was made to utilities last week (looking for sales/usage info).
- Delay on getting NEEP team engaged in portfolio.
 - This project will help guide the suggestions of programs for 2009 and later.
 - Need to start 2009 program and budget ideas. Goal is to have final package submitted 9/30/08 to board (hope to have contract modifications by 10/1/08).
- Date of release of NEEP study not available yet.
- The CRA work must proceed on its schedule regardless of NEEP schedule.
- Utilities have requested ongoing administrative support.
- Utilities still working with Compliance Filings.



- These filings are for Low-income, Clean Power Choice, DCA, EDA.
- Market Managers need budget direction from Staff in terms of allocations among initiatives.
- Need guidance from Staff to determine if something belongs in RGGI or other programs (this is an open question).
- Concept of utilities developing new programs and coordinating with existing programs is in draft.
 - Best avenue may be for utilities to coordinate with EEC/Honeywell and TRC.
- Request was made to develop new programs, ideas and budgets for 2009.
 - Idea is to share information with utilities, have two way communications and support each other to grow and sell the program.

4. Status of Market Managers 2008 Contract Modifications & Impact on 2009 Planning Process:

- Treasury is not ready to approve.
- Additional information was sent to treasury 5/12.
- Issues are \$ compared to original bid prices.
 - Working to demonstrate to Treasury that the increase in \$ is because the programs have grown.
- New programs are to kick off 4 months from when Treasury approves.
- Municipal Audit program has issued & closed RFP for auditors, put no decision and no program in place yet.
 - Contract modifications have not been approved yet to administer the program.

5. 2009 Preliminary Program Considerations:

- Idea is for the same program approach for 2009.
- How do Market Managers work with the utilities?
 - Utilities have a compliance filing.
 - Utilities would be contracted with treasury (this is on hold).
 - Looking into separate budget for utilities.

6. 2008 Program Issues:

Program Updates (Market Managers)

C/I – programs proceeding as planned (2008 programs).

- 2007 CHP applications
 - Staff questions have been answered and very close to Board approval.
- Three CHP checks were issued for 2005.
 - Bristol Myers Squibb, Raritan Valley Community College, Ortho Clinical Diagnostics — ~\$1M each.
 - Working on press events for these checks.
- New program ideas for 2009
 - Increase CHP budget
 - Increase Municipal Audit Budget
 - Increase Pay for Performance Budget
 - Increase Direct Install Budget
 - Increase Incentive Cap to \$1,000,000 per customer, per calendar year
